For some who have been here we have included some pictures of the scene down where Walt Disney filmed "Pirates of the Caribbean". These were taken on Thursday 16 Oct. 2008. By Friday the restaurant was open for business. Actually, very little damage was done.

You will note the small building out front is just some pillars, they took it down some time ago due to age/rot (this is the tropics, and untreated wood is prime target for insects, and mold, and fungus).

We have had a low in our attendance for reasons that we can't explain. Generally about now, we start having a higher attendance towards Christmas.
